

BIDDERS NOTES

The successful bidder is expected to note the following requirements that are expected during the award

Bidders must provide proof of a valid Public Liability Insurance not less than the value of R2 million (Certified copy of insurance policy) or letter of intent to obtain the Public Liability Insurance not less than the value of R 2 million from the accredited insurance company;

A successful bidder will be required to adhere to the following requirements as regards working at heights:

Should the contractor select to utilize scaffolding, it will be required of the contractor to appoint a competent person to undertake oversight of the scaffolding work operations, including ensuring that all scaffold erectors, team leaders and inspectors are competent to carry out their duties. The said person must, at minimum, be in possession of a Level 2 NQF Qualification in Put locking 20m, Interlocking 30m, Free standing or walk through 45m, Tub2ing or systems 60m; OR

Where machinery is selected as an alternative technique, the contractor will be required to designate a competent person in a full time capacity to oversee the machinery work operations in the premises. The said person must possess the qualifications and have experience as prescribed in the definition of “competent person” in regulation 1 of the General Machinery Regulations (first published in GN R1521 of August 1988), promulgated under section 35 of the Machinery and Occupational Safety Act 6 of 1983.
